

Introductory Proteomics (April 29-30, 2006)

This course is aimed at graduate students, postdoctoral fellows, and professors interested in applying proteomics to their research. The course will provide an introduction to biological mass spectrometry with the emphasis on proteomics. Topics include sample preparation for MS studies, common instrumentation and separation techniques, peptide mass fingerprinting, peptide sequencing by tandem mass spectrometry, post-translational modification analysis, and quantitative proteomics. Practical workshops will familiarize participants with off-line and internet-based software tools and will include database searching and interpretation of data.

Cost: \$500/person includes 2 lunches, breaks, and course notes.
